## NEW STUDY ON VACCINATION GAPS

A new study on vaccination gaps was published in December by Trust for America's Health and the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation. This report examines U.S. policies regarding infectious disease threats. One of the findings of the study on reasons attributed to vaccination gaps is the underfunding of immunization registries. # DISCOVERY SESSIONS FOR NEW IIS MANAGERS AND STAFF

# **Assessment Steering Committee**

- The ASC met on December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2013. The committee continued discussing the development of an assessment tool, focusing on confidentiality issues, data sharing agreements, tool design and format for data submissions.
- The University of Michigan submitted a draft report on findings from the survey they conducted on behalf of AIRA to learn about IIS-based assessment practices. Results from this survey will be presented to the AIRA community when final.

#### Standards and Interoperability Steering Committee

- The SISC met on December 11<sup>th</sup>, 2013. After many years of service, Emily Emerson has stepped down as Co-Chair of the SISC. AIRA is thankful for Emily's insightful leadership and wishes her well in her new role as Assistant Division Director for the Minnesota Department of Health. Mary Beth Kurilo (OR) will serve as interim Co-Chair while a search is conducted. If you are interested in being considered for this role please contact Alison Chi at achi@immregistries.org
- The SISC will be reviewing the HL7 EHR Child Health Functional Profile which is up for a reaffirmation ballot in January.
- The SISC finished review of the HL7 2.5.1 Implementation Guide update which will be released early in 2014.
- The SISC discussed a proposal from HL7 for a user group in the immunization space, which might serve as a good way to work with vendors implementing interfaces. The committee agreed to send this topic to the AIRA Board for further discussion and review.

#### **Education Steering Committee**

 The ESC met on December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Committee members discussed the next issue of SnapShots, which will be released at the beginning of January.

- The ESC also planned for upcoming AIRA educational webinars. Look for webinar announcements in your email, in the monthly update, and on the AIRA website.
- The ESC began discussions on the education survey that will be conducted in 2014 to assess the education needs of AIRA members.

## **MIROW Steering Committee**

- The MIROW Steering Committee met on December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2013. The committee discussed MIROW-related IISAR results, and the current evaluation of MIROW guides by the University of Michigan.
- The committee also discussed topics for the next MIROW chapter.
- A special Steering Committee call to continue discussions regarding selection of a new topic for analysis – is scheduled for *Thursday*, *January 9<sup>th</sup>*, *2014*, *4:00-5:00 PM ET*.
