- Step One Plan for System
- Step Two Build or Acquire System

- Quarterly mailing to ALL Vermont providers
- Year One Focus on HPV
- Include INITIATION and COMPLETION rates
- Lots of ongoing HPV initiatives in VT Compare practice to State Rates

### **Critical Questions**

- What to include?
  - Discussed with Immunization Program.
- Who gets the information?
  - Vaccine Manager
- How does it get sent?
  - We snail mailed it!
- Is there follow-up for good/bad performance?
  - Alerted AFIX assessors about poor performers.
  - Alerted immunization program about good ones!






## Outcome: HPV Progress Over Time
