


Overall Goal



Oversee project(s) to leverage collaborative methods

 Identify criteria and select candidate projects for JDI focus

Effectively communicate IIS JDI scope and status

 Communicate core challenge, engage full community, update regularly

Coordinate with repository

 Leverage repository as project planning platform and location for JDI outputs


Plan for innovative funding mechanisms to support future approaches

 Advocate for funding/services that allow programs to apply/benefit jointly






Overarching Concepts





Exploring Innovative Funding Mechanisms

- Have taken a research/exploration approach
 - Tracking progress of current AFIX/BPA Project
 - Compiling information on open source/public domain examples/considerations
 - Anticipating working closely with CDC to inform future funding mechanisms



What's Working Well Across JDI? Early Progress



The infrastructure has been created to support greater collaboration across platforms



A process has been stood up and tested to select and govern JDI projects



An innovative initial project is underway that should yield a beneficial service for the IIS community







Strategies to Address Remaining Challenges

- Continue to work closely with our CDC partners to help shape approaches to JDI funding
- Fully operationalize governance structure
- Build out tools such as the AIRA repository that allow for greater visibility and cross-pollination
- Test and expand the boundaries of JDI with concrete projects
