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




- Alaska operates a Vaccine Depot for vaccine distribution throughout the state
 - Alaska is the largest state in the U.S.
 - 20% of Alaska's population resides in communities with
 <2,500 population (source: Alaska Dept. of Labor Workforce and Development 2013 population estimates)
 - Many Alaska rural communities are only accessible by boat or bush plane












Vaccine Depot Workflow







Dose-level accountability:

- Providers are required to account for every vaccine dose decremented from their stock
 - IIS prompts reconciliation of their inventory prior to ordering




Reducing Vaccine Waste using the IIS



Depot oversight over wasted vaccines:

 All vaccines accounted as wasted are processed in the IIS and generates a return back to the Depot

New Tools in 2015:

- Aggregate Wastage Report changes
- Vaccine Wastage Alert

Provides:

- Increased accountability of vaccine usage by providers
- Status update to providers on their storage and handling practices
- Better picture for Alaska on the types of wastage providers are recording so they can target training efforts accordingly
- More accurate data on vaccine wastage reported to the CDC



How it works:



Sum of Vaccines Wasted in 12 months

Sum of Vaccines Received in 12 months

x 100 = % of Vaccine Wasted in 12 months

Example: If the current month is April...

Sum of Vaccines Wasted from April 20, 2013 through April 19, 2014
Sum of Vaccines Received from April 20, 2013 through April 19, 2014

= % of Vaccine Wasted in 12 months



Vaccine Wastage Alert roll out

Phase one:

- Education and training regarding new functionality
- Implement alert for all providers to maintain a 5% wastage rate
- Initial focus will be on expired vaccine
- Providers exceeding wastage rate will be required to complete educational trainings

Phase two:

 Identify and focus on providers with frequent temperature excursions
