

## Assumption: AFIX Assessment

 AFIX is a quality improvement strategy used by Immunization Programs to increase vaccine coverage and promote best practices around immunization.

## Vermont Immunization Registry

- IMR Application developed in-house.
- IMR live since 2004.
- AFIX conducted by Immunization Designees (PH Nurses) at local Health Offices.
- IMR active participation close to 75%.



IIS just launched. Co-Casa for AFIX. Manual entry all data.

Export from IIS loaded into Co-CASA.

> IIS interaction integral to AFIX visit.


## Close, but No (?) Cigar

### **PROS**

- IMR reports exclude invalid doses automatically from coverage rates.
- IMR reports clearly indicate missed series and invalid doses.
- Providers can immediately run recall reports based on the assessment.

### **CONS**

- Precise information about missed opportunities not easily available.
- Providers need to look at individual records to assess problems.
- Forecaster does not display reason for invalid doses.


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



Lots of possible reports – how to streamline?

Changes cost money and effort.

 AFIX Assessments often coincide with VFC visits. With the addition of new VFC requirements, decreased time for AFIX.

## Results


AFIX reports give useful information.

- Puts EVALUATION into provider hands
  - "Just enough" information.
  - Provider can choose area of focus.
  - Measurable Improvements.
  - Useful for other QC projects.
    - E.g. AAP licensing
