






Children < 6 years with 2+ Immunizations in a Registry, 2002









A Brief History of AIRA

- All Kids Count Project from 1992-1999
 - Robert Wood Johnson grant funded the startup of several state IIS
 - Provided conferences & technical assistance
- IIS teams recognized the need for continuation of this type of mutual support
- AIRA, as a membership-based non-profit organization, began in 1999





Vision & Mission

- Vision: A healthy, fully immunized community supported by the electronic sharing of information.
- Mission: to promote the electronic use, tracking and sharing of complete immunization records for people of all ages.




Organizational Structure
