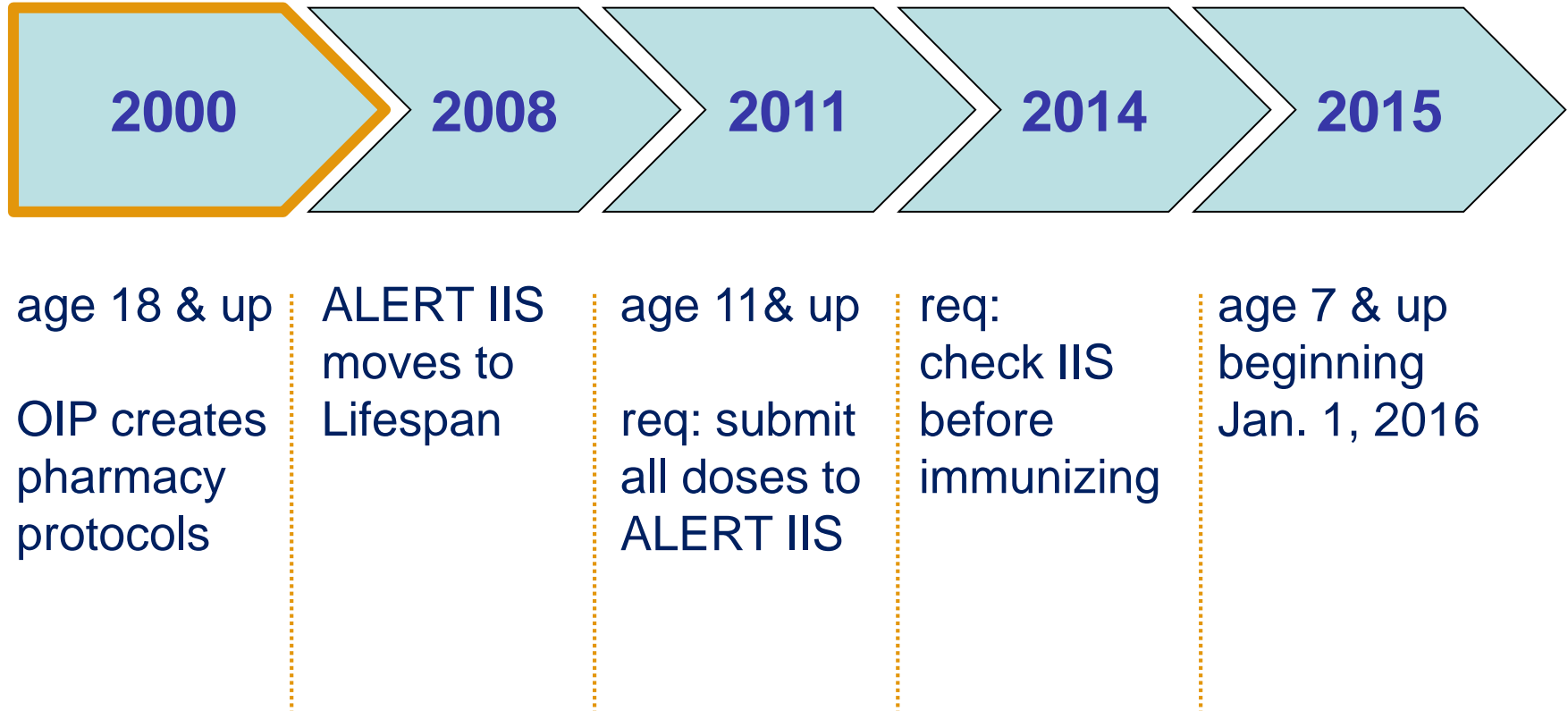

OREGON HEALTH AUTHORITY IMMUNIZATION PROTOCOL FOR PHARMACISTS Human Papilloma Virus Vaccines (HPV)

Revisions as of 06-01-2015


The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommends¹:

- **Any** available HPV vaccine product may be used to continue or complete the 3–dose series for females for protection against HPV 16 and 18.
- **HPV4 or HPV9** may be used to continue or complete the 3–dose series for males for protection against HPV 6, 11, 16 and 18.
- Vaccination with HPV should not be delayed to procure HPV9.
- If persons reach age 27 years before the HPV vaccination series is complete, the second and third doses of vaccine can be administered at 27 years of age.^{1, 2}

I. Order:

1. Check the ALERT Immunization Information System (IIS) to determine whether the patient needs this vaccine and any other vaccines.

Immunization Information for Health Care Providers

VFC Program

The [Vaccines for Children Program \(VFC\)](#) supplies federally purchased free vaccines for immunizing eligible children in public and private practices - at no cost to participating private health care providers. Approximately 60 percent of U.S. children may be expected to benefit from the VFC Program.

Patients through age 18 are eligible if they are:

- enrolled in Medicaid or The Oregon Health Plan;
- uninsured; or
- American Indian/Alaskan Native.

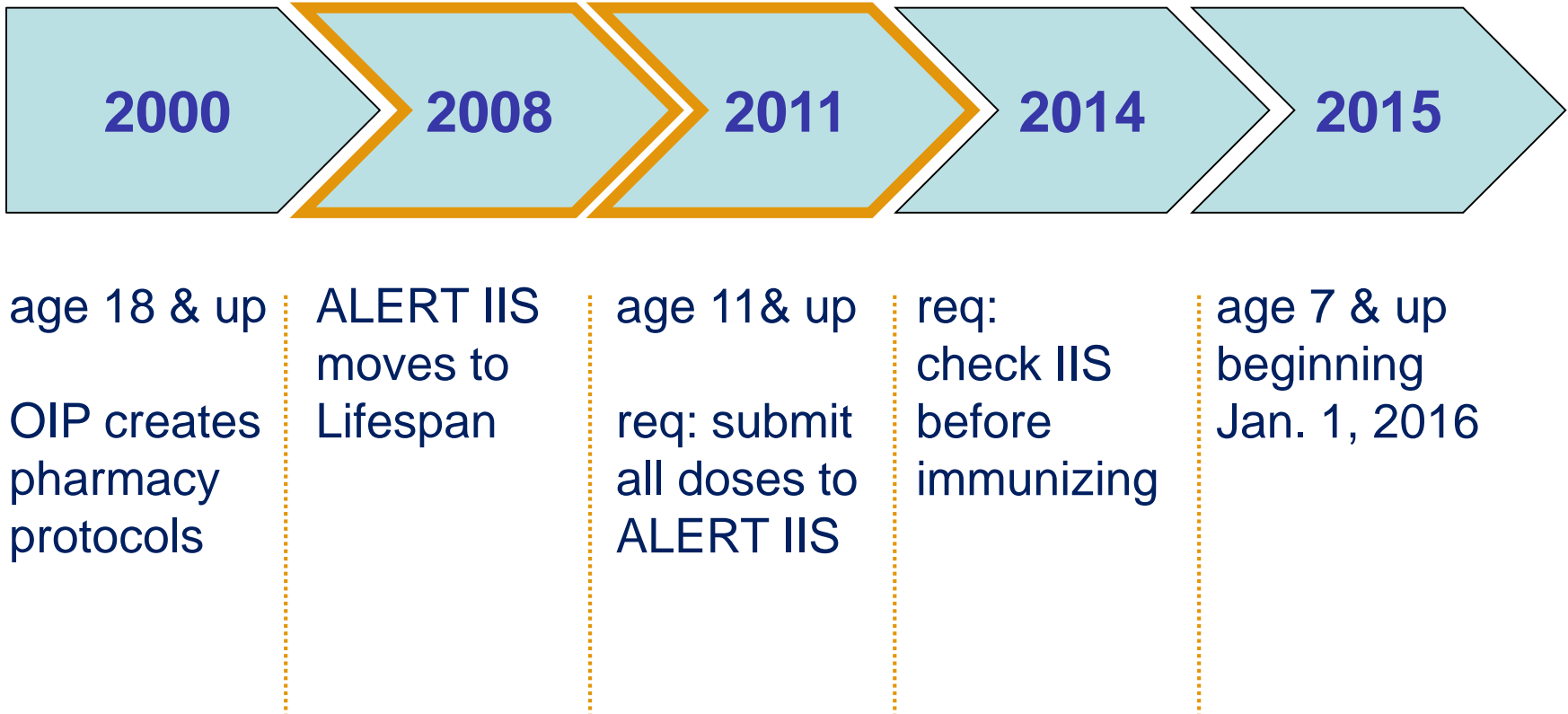

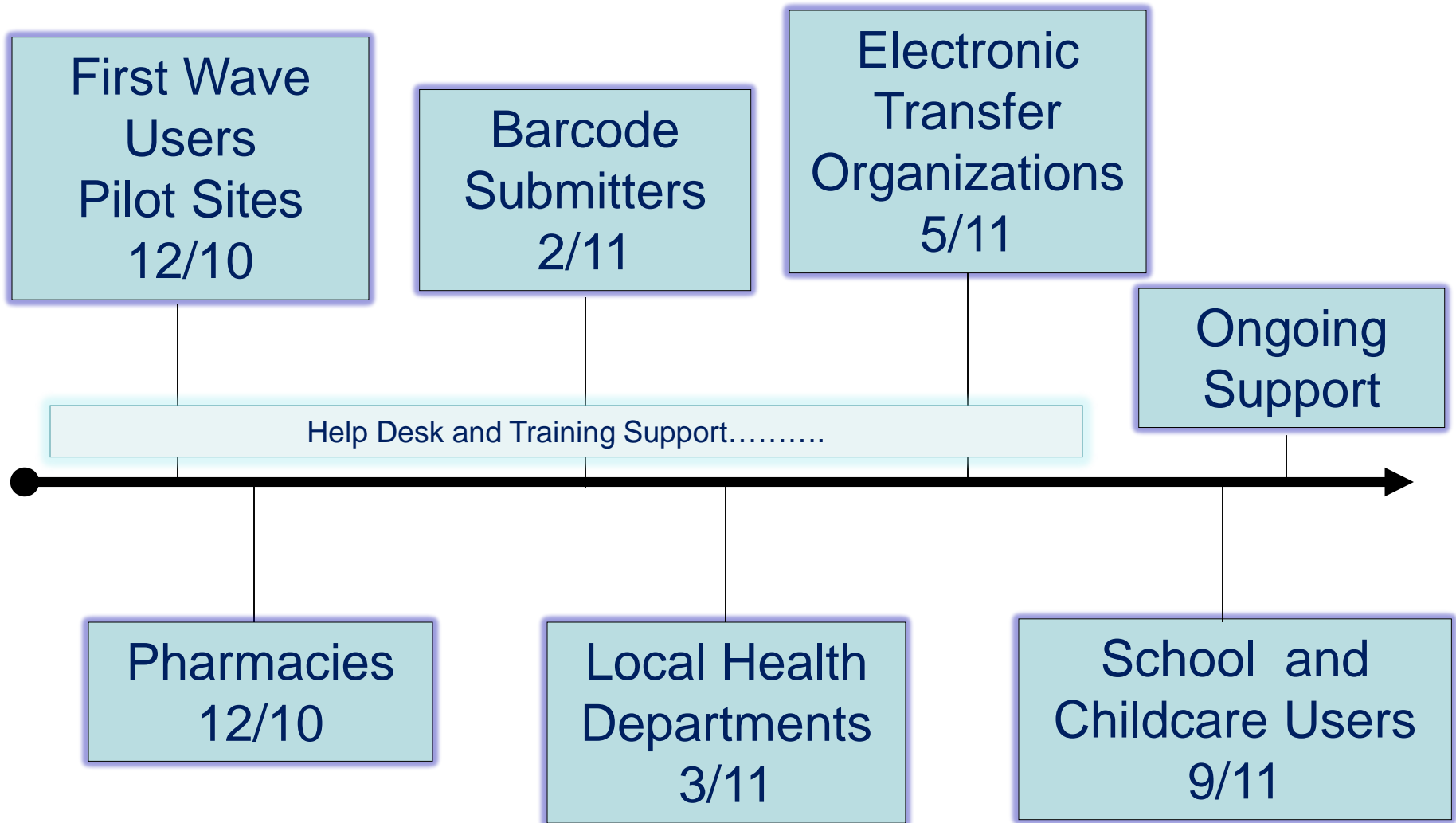

- Stakeholders
 - ask more of them, they want to be a part of the process
- Pharmacy Workflow
 - does not equal clinic workflow
 - corporate chains and independent pharmacies have different needs
- Pharmacy Access
 - must get IIS website on approved list
 - links off website do not work (training videos)
 - different rules about IIS access for pharmacy techs
 - data systems are not necessarily EHR's
- Training
 - Feedback is critical
