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Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR) Background

- 1996 Legislation
 - Opt out rules
 - Vital Records integration
 - Mandated Reporting



History of MCIR

- Web-based application
- Populated with electronic birth records, usually within 2 weeks
- Operational with a regional approach
- Majority of the funding from the Healthy Michigan Fund (tobacco tax)
- First rolled out in 1998
- Became a lifespan registry in 2006



How Data is submitted to IIS (MCIR)

- Hand Key (Direct Data Entry)
- Transfer data via electronic interface
 - HL7 2.5.1
 - Flat File



MCIR Activity and Information

- ❖6.9 million individuals
- ❖83 million+ immunization records
- \$15,000 to 36,000 user logins daily
- ❖5,500 provider sites
- 4,100 Childcare facilities
- 4,900 school buildings
- ❖9,000-14,000 reports generated daily




IIS Assessment and Michigan

- Chart Reviews using CoCASA (1996-2006)
- IIS used to compliment CoCASA data (2001-2006)
- Quality Data Comparison (2002 2004)
 - Information collected from the patient chart was compared with the information in the IIS (MCIR)
 - Dose dates added to MCIR
 - Dose dates found in MCIR
 - Taken to the provider office at AFIX feedback meeting
 - Duplicate dose dates corrected manually in IIS




Quality Data Comparison - Michigan AFIX Program

- Training site visit reviewers on AFIX
 (AFIX site visits are conducted at every VFC provider that receives a VFC compliance visit)
- Programming of AFIX reports into the IIS




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AFIX Reports available in the IIS


