A Little About Washington State

- Population: About 7 million
- Universal vaccine purchase
- About 1,100 enrolled providers
- Decentralized public health
 - 35 independent local health jurisdictions (LHJs).
 - Contract with LHJs to provide frontline support to providers (e.g. VFC enrollment, site visits).







WA Immunization Information System

- Lifetime Immunization Information System (IIS).
- No provider requirement to participate or submit data.
- 100% of VFC providers participate in the IIS.
- 23 different EHR products with live interfaces.
 - Covering 802 provider sites.



AFIX/IIS Integration Challenges



Funding

- It's not just the initial development.
- Need a sustainable funding source.





Staffing and Knowledge

- Staff time and competing work priorities.
- Translating program needs to IIS programmers.





Building in Flexibility

- Changing AFIX
 assessment
 requirements.
- Other coverage assessment needs.

- Making many changes to IIS functionality.






Provider Trust of Data
