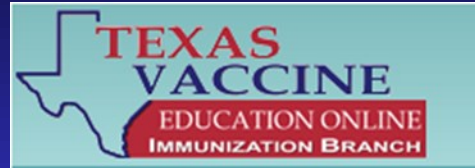

Vaccine Education Online



- What is the VEO LMS?
 - A learning management system developed by DSHS Immunization Branch to provide short online courses on topics related to vaccines
 - The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) grant requirements require DSHS Immunization Branch to provide education and training relating to vaccine preventable diseases available to all audience types
 - Courses are free and designed for specific audiences, such as health-care provider, school personnel, parents, and local health departments

Vaccine Education Online



- Who Maintains the VEO Web-Portal?
 - MicroAssist, a primary training vendor for the State of Texas, hosts & maintains training portal per annual agreement
 - DSHS Immunization Branch creates and develops all e-learning curriculum housed on web-portal
 - MicroAssist and DSHS meet annually to upgrade, re-design, or change content/layout of VEO training portal

Functions of VEO

- VEO Learning Management System (LMS) - Moodle
- All courses were created in Lectora
- VEO currently houses 26 courses specifically categorized by audience type
- Each individual training course serves an important purpose in educating our constituents on vaccines.
- VEO will serve as the ‘go-to’ site for all training purposes and up-to-date vaccine resource for Immunization employees, etc., - currently in progress
- All courses meet the Federal 508 accessibility requirements






Click any term, and then click its definition to match them. You may use the Glossary if you wish. When you have matched everything, click the **SUBMIT** button.

Historical Immunizations	Any federal, state, local, or private personnel who may respond to a disaster.
Current immunizations	An automated feature that produces a letter that can be printed out and mailed to clients reminding them that their vaccinations are past due.
Wild Carding	Immunizations that were administered within the last 28 days.
First Responder	Allows people to use asterisk (*) or question mark (?) as placeholders for unknown letters when conducting a Basic Search.
Recall	Immunizations that were administered more than 28 days ago and/or at another site.

Why should I sign up for ImmTrac?



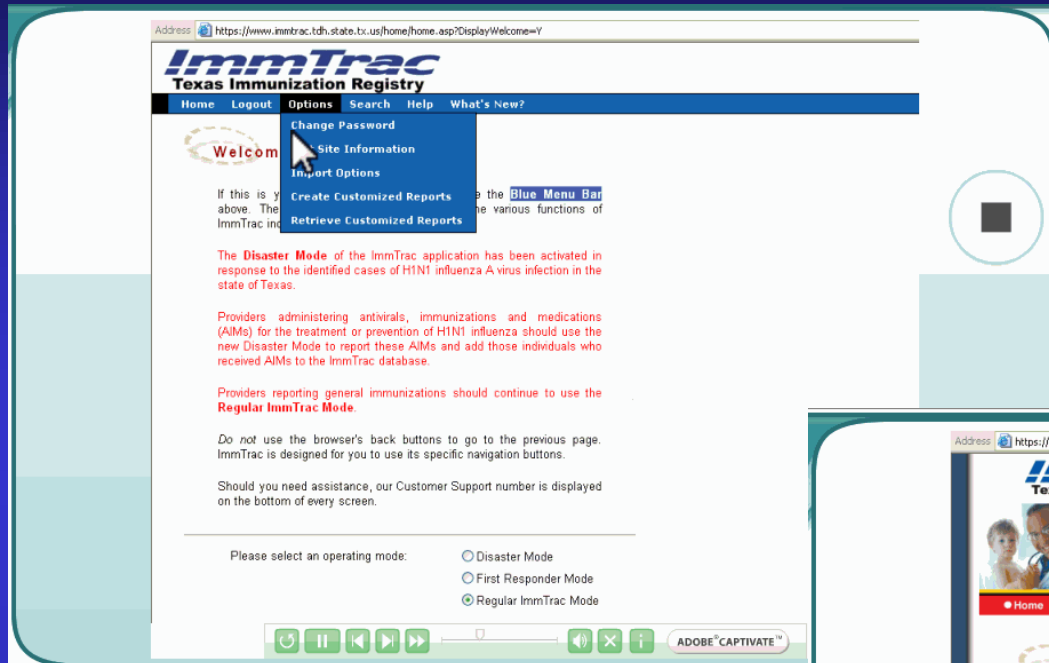
Why should providers register with ImmTrac? Because:

- ImmTrac has Health Level Seven (HL7) capability.

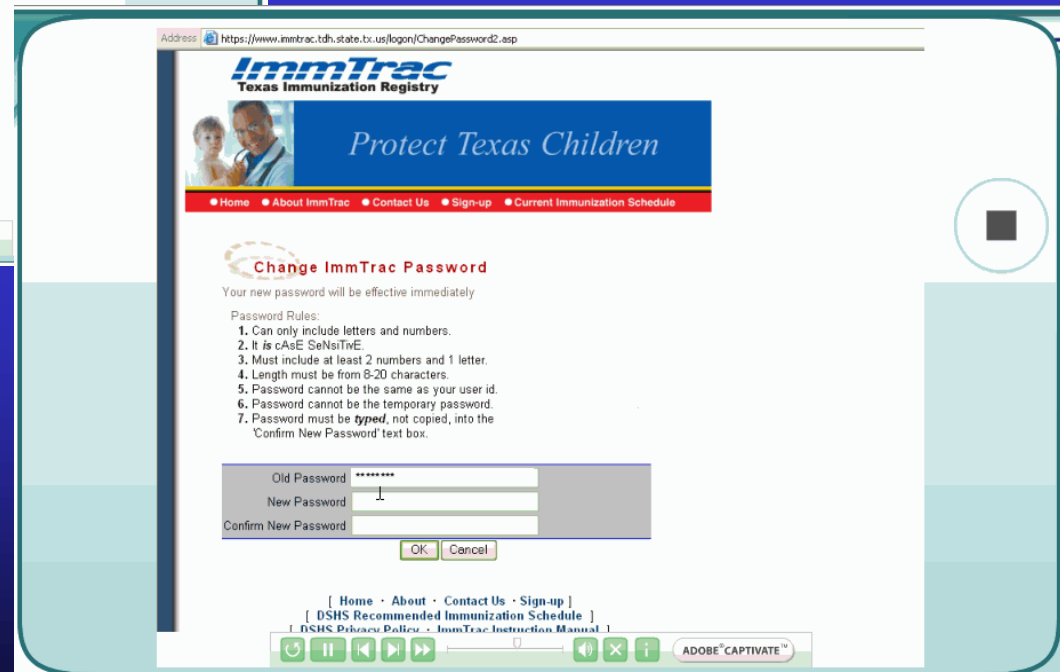

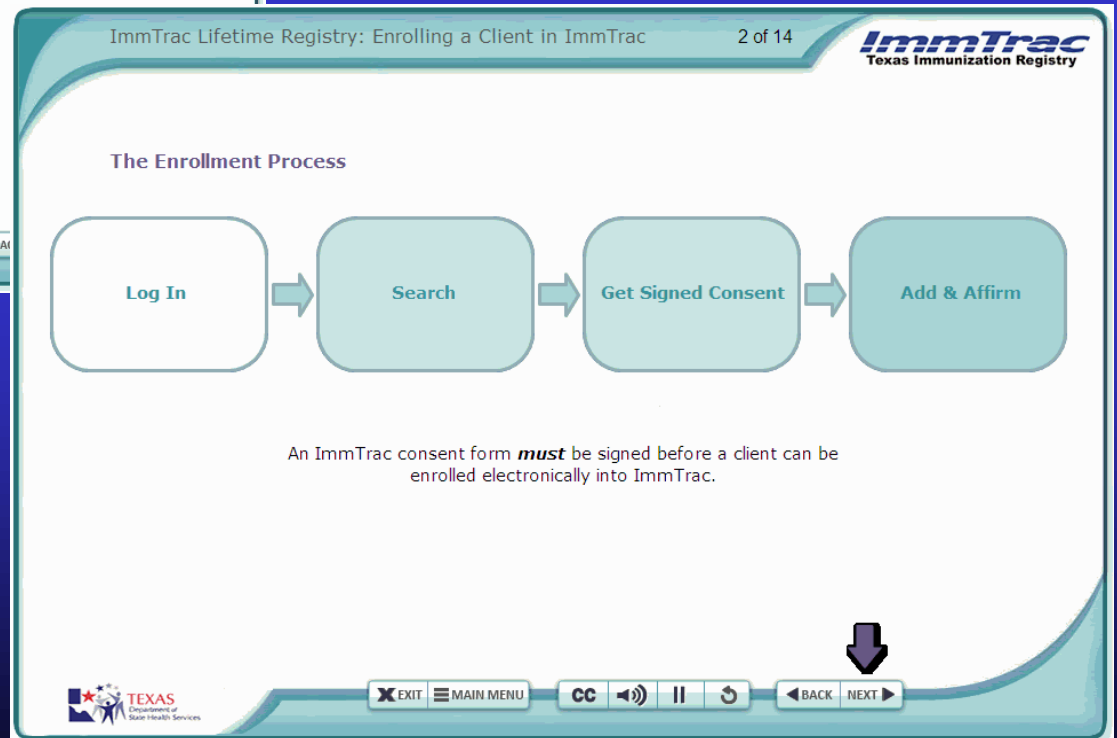
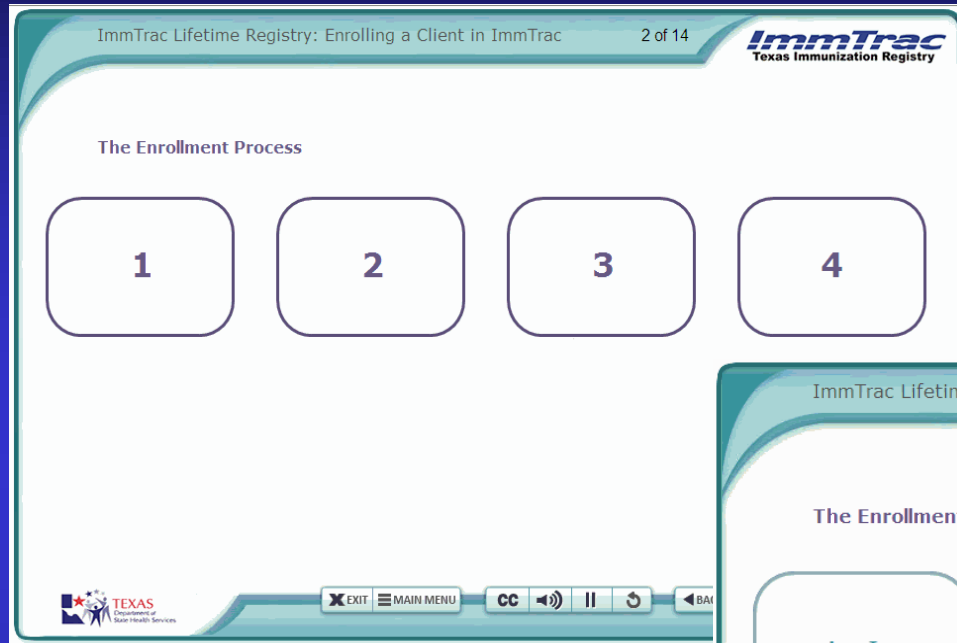
