GOALS OF AFIX PROGRAM


- A scientific method of determining how well a provider is immunizing their patients.
- Identify areas of needed improvement.
- Encourage office practice changes that could increase office immunization rates.
- Follow up to make sure the provider has successfully instituted the changes he/she agreed to.

GOALS OF THE AFIX PROGRAM AFIX IS NOT A REMINDER/RECALL PROGRAM

BEFORE NV WEBIZ

THE QA COORDINATOR WAS CONDEMNED TO:

5-6 HOURS OF SITTING
IN A PROVIDER'S OFFICE
WITH 50 PATIENTS'
CHARTS AND HAND
ENTERING ENTIRE
PATIENT
IMMUNIZATION
RECORDS INTO CoCASA.



JULY 2009

State law requires that providers who vaccinate children enter the vaccine administration data into NV WebIZ, the NV state immunization registry.

Entry of historical immunization data is not required but encouraged.

2013

During 2013, providers are being evaluated on the immunization status of children born in 2010 (one year after the mandatory use of NV WebIZ was instituted.)

PATIENT ROSTER

- Are there 10 or more active patients in the birth cohort?
- Are there more than 100 active patients?
- Are there obvious duplicates?
- Are there patients who have not visited in the last 23 years?

IMMUNIZATION RATES FOR PROVIDER

 NV WebIZ supplies series rates and individual antigen rates at age 24 months and on the date the report is generated.

THESE RATES ARE NOT ACCURATE BUT A MINIMUM RATE. DATA MUST BE "CLEANED" –

Duplicates combined, inactive patients removed, missing historical data entered.

POSSIBLE PATIENT DUPLICATES

- Provider is contacted to verify if records are duplicates or multiple births.
- Identified duplicate records are combined by the NV WebIZ staff before the CoCASA export is accomplished.
- Cleans up the patients' records to prevent over immunization and creates a cleaner data base to generate reminder/recall info.

VACCINES ADDED BUT NOT ADMINISTERED

Notated by a red syringe on the NVWebIZ record

- Helps with data clean up
- Correction of the red syringe prevents over immunization.

CoCASA EXPORT (Parameters to choose)

- Provider
- Clinic
- Age range
- Common review date
- Insurance / VFC status
- Exclude MOGE patients (inactive)


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
NV WEBIZ EXPORT FOR CoCASA IMPORT

- NV WebIZ #
- Last Name
- First Name
- Middle Initial
- Gender
- Date of birth
- HL7 code for vaccine

- Shot date
- Race
- Ethnicity
- VFC eligibility
- Last date of vaccination
- Had chickenpox
- MOGE







DATA REVIEW IN CoCASA

Each child's record must be reviewed in NV WebIZ to determine if it belongs in the IZ study.

DELETE FROM CoCASA IF:

- Child presented to the provider after 2nd Bday
- Child is obviously seeing another provider (change ownership to that new provider)
- Child had only one visit on record and it was before age 6 months (MOGE)
- Parent vaccine refusal is documented in NVWebIZ

REPORTS IN CoCASA

- 4.3.1.3.3.1 Series Summary Report
- 4.3.1.3.3.1.4 Series Summary Report
- Single Antigen Report
- Missing Immunization Report
- Demographic Report (VFC eligibility report)
- Patient List

NV WEBIZ REMINDER/RECALL

Valuable resource to increase immunization rates. Doesn't work if data is not accurate!

- Programs must be closed for MOGE patients
- Demographics must be updated so the phone calls and postcards are delivered
- IZ records must be accurate (duplicate records must be combined, missing historical data must be added to NV WebIZ, added but not administered doses must be corrected)

NV WEBIZ RECOMMENDER

- Identifies immunizations that are due the day the child is in the office.
- Prevents invalid doses due to lack of minimum age or minimum interval.
- Reinforces clinical judgment.
- Identifies when a child needs to return for future immunization-helps the front office staff schedule future appointments.

AFIX AND NV WEBIZ

- Saves QA coordinator from sitting in the provider's office for 5 hours doing data entry into CoCASA.
- DO NOT DUMP DATA FROM THE REGISTRY AND PRINT CoCASA REPORTS!
- Each patient record must be viewed in NVWebIZ prior to inclusion in the IZ assessment.
- Data in the registry must be updated by the provider or state staff so that NV WebIZ tools can be used by the provider staff.
