THE DEFINITION OF IISAR, PER CDC:

THE IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION SYSTEMS ANNUAL REPORT (IISAR) IS AN ANNUAL ASSESSMENT CONDUCTED BY CDC, NATIONAL CENTER FOR IMMUNIZATION AND RESPIRATORY DISEASES (NCIRD), IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION SYSTEMS (IIS) SUPPORT BRANCH, AMONG THE 64 IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM GRANTEES THAT RECEIVE FUNDING UNDER SECTION 317B OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE ACT. GRANTEES INCLUDE THE 50 STATES, 5 CITIES, THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA (D.C.) AND 8 TERRITORIES.

- *SELF-ADMINISTERED WEB-BASED QUESTIONNAIRE COMPLETED BY IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM MANAGERS AS PART OF THEIR ANNUAL REPORTING REQUIREMENT.*
- *MISSION IS TO PROVIDE ACCESS AND VISIBILITY TO THESE DATA AND TO ASSIST IN FACILITATING THEIR USE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH PROJECTS.*

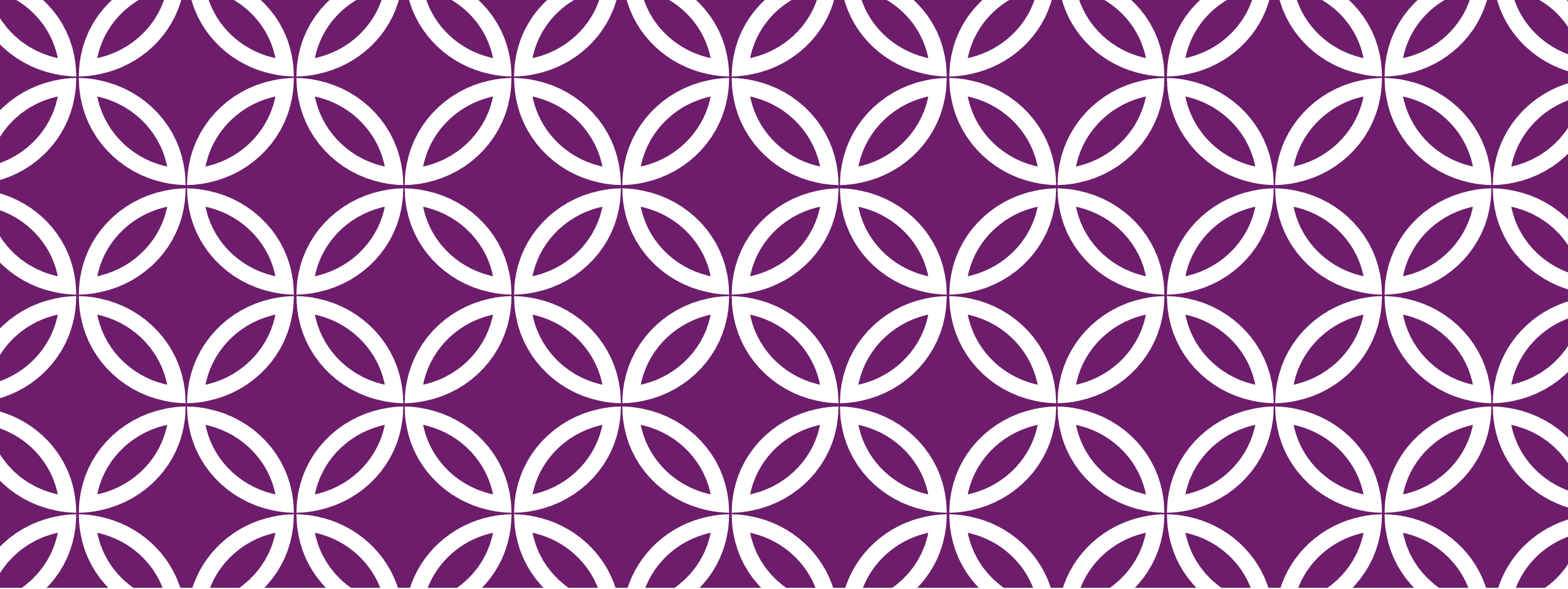

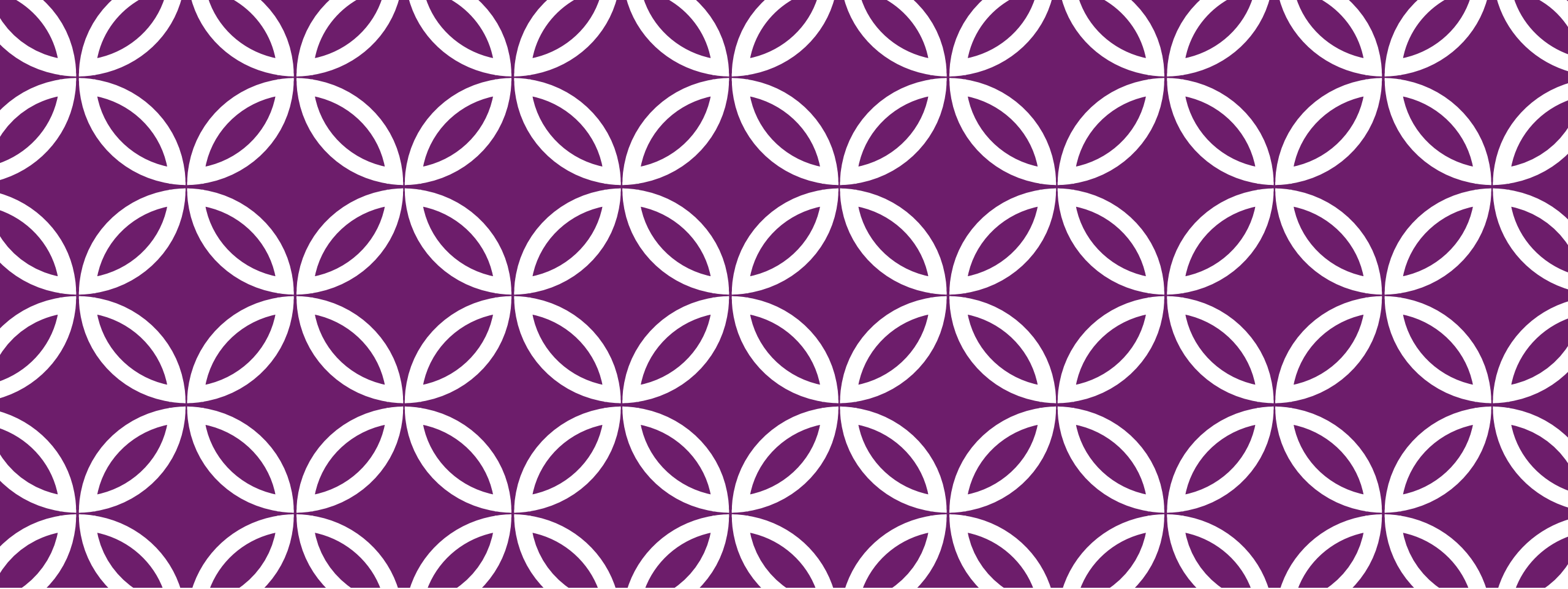
