# NESIIS History

- ▶ Fairly young system in data exchange (system launch in 2008, DX in 2010)
  - Client level eligibility
- ▶ Functional Enhancements:
  - Dose Level Eligibility (February 2011)
  - Perinatal Hep B Module (May 2012)
  - HL7 2.5.1 (February 2013)
  - SOAP Web Services (March 2013)
  - Query/Response (January 2013)
  - Deduct from Inventory (coming soon)




# User Interface:

- ▶ Required field for manual entry
- ▶ Ability to set the same eligibility for each immunization provided at that visit.

# Data Exchange

- ▶ NESIIS Help Desk works with providers/vendors to send vaccine eligibility codes via data exchange (flat and HL7)
- ▶ Some EHRs are unable to capture appropriate dose level eligibility and send nothing
- ▶ Some EHRs are unable to capture dose level eligibility and use client level eligibility for each dose administered (not ideal)
- ▶ Necessary for VFC doses administered tracking/reporting

# Deduct from Inventory:

- ▶ Vaccine Eligibility code will be necessary for providers wishing to deduct doses received through DX from inventory – especially if they can't send funding source
- ▶ NESIIS uses funding source and eligibility to determine/verify appropriate lot to deduct from
- ▶ How do we “require” eligibility through DX if EHRs can't provide it?



# Dose Level Eligibility Uses:

- ▶ Special projects using publicly purchased vaccines
- ▶ Vaccine accountability: with the ever-increasing levels of CDC reporting requirements it's important to be able to justify/verify vaccination administration rates by eligibility
- ▶ VFC Provider Profiles: eligibility data can be used to verify VFC vaccine order levels/needs

# Challenges:

- ▶ End User training to stress the importance of capturing the appropriate eligibility at time of service
- ▶ Increased screening time to determine eligibility
- ▶ Appropriate identification prior to vaccine administration – coordination with administering nurse and data entry
- ▶ Many EHRs are not able to capture and/or send dose level eligibility
- ▶ What do you do with existing records where eligibility was captured at the client level?



# Successes from Dose Level Eligibility:

- ▶ Improved accountability
- ▶ Provides supporting data for special projects
- ▶ Provides supporting data for reporting
- ▶ Provides better VFC Profiling and educational opportunities during VFC site visits
- ▶ Improves ability to determine pockets of need and success rate of services provided
- ▶ Allows providers to run/create their own reports to monitor accountability
