- Currently contains over 16,606,858 immunizations on over 1,967,309 clients






- Manual User Interface

- No mandate to report












NESIIS added 94 new organizations in 2016, adding more than 30% during the month of September.

Multiple phased approach:

Phase 1:

- Develop plan to monitor data frequency and timeliness
- Ensure providers continuously send data based off of their previous trends
- Allows us to track provider participation
- Allows us to determine population representativeness

- Develop plan to monitor data quality and completeness
- Ensure providers continuously send good/appropriate data
- Allows us to track data quality issues
- Allows us to determine immunization completeness and rates



- Clear, consistent, firm guidelines
- Optimize testing
- Be responsive

Monitor jobs

- Most organizations are submitting records continuously
- Identify immediately if DX drops off

Monitor records

- Identify problems with the HL7 format/structure
- Identify problem with the organization's data
- Help new organizations establish quality data exchange





- Track job status and volume
- Completed
- Failed (exception or error)
- Track records
- Volume
- Status (processed or rejected)
- Rejection reasons
- Trends
 - NESIIS Level
 - Vendor, parent, and organization-specific



- Initially reviewed randomly chosen samples
- New sample size determination process
- Achieve 95% confidence with 5% variance
- Review at least 1 record per sending org
- Actual number is proportional to orgs share of NESIIS rejections





$$s = X^2NP(1-P) \div d^2(N-1) + X^2P(1-P)$$

s = required sample size

 X^2 = the table value of chi-square for 1 degree of freedom at the desired confidence level (3.841)


N = the population size

P = the population proportion (assumed to be .50 since this would provide the maximum sample size)

d = the degree of accuracy expressed as a proportion (.05)
