KIDSNET Background



- Integrated child health information system for maternal and child health programs
- Facilitates the collection and appropriate sharing of health data by authorized users for the provision of timely and appropriate preventive health services and follow up
- ***IIS is built into KIDSNET

Current – Schools



- ***User agreements at school district level
 - District gives and terminates IIS access

Staff look up records one at a time

- ***Federal Laws
 - ******HIPAA
 - ***FERPA

- **State Laws**
 - ***Confidentiality of Health Care Act



What about HIPAA?



The Privacy Rule expressly permits personal health information (PHI) to be shared for specified public health purposes..... Further, the Privacy Rule permits covered entities to make disclosures that are required by other laws, including laws that require disclosures for public health purposes



What about State Law?



The Confidentiality of Health Care Communications and Information Act permits release or transfer of confidential health care information without consent "between and among qualified personnel and health care providers within the health care system for purposes of coordination of health care services...."



What about FERPA?



Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) authorizes the disclosure of personally identifiable information (PII) contained in educational records to federal and state officials for purposes relating to accountability and research, including the audit, evaluation, and compliance andenforcement of federal or state supported educationprograms

- ***Roster data only
- ***Schools evaluate compliance with school regs



Data Sharing Agreement



Data sourced from the KIDSNET system will be used for the following purposes:

d. To evaluate school programs to assure that all children have received developmental screening, immunizations, and other preventive health services during early childhood and beyond to promote health and educational success.



Roster Data Collected



- Monthly since November 2015
- **Demographics for matching
- ***School District
- ***School
- ***Grade



Data Linkage to IIS



- ***Demographics for matching
- ***Plain text ASCII file, one record per line, CSV format
- Combination of deterministic and probabilistic match process
 - **A high (98%) match percentage is achieved
- Unmatched records are stored and included in reports under "no info. in IIS"

Report Development



- ★★Draft by IIS staff
- ***Met with key partners for review
 - **Immunization Program
 - ***School Nurses
 - ***State Epidemiologists
- ***Revised based on input



School Reports




- *** Assuring school requirements are met
 - List of children: met, not met, or no information in IIS
 - Identify missing vaccine group(s)
 - **Include PCP contact information
 - Sort or select by school, grade
- In an outbreak to identify children who are eligible to receive a vaccine
- Roster list by school by grade

School Reports, cont'd.



- ***Access is controlled at district level
 - Users added and terminated by administrator
 - Each user in district can run reports for any school and grade in the district

Results

Total number of children in school/district: 100

Total number of children in KIDSNET not meeting the selected Requirement: 1

Total number of children in KIDSNET meeting the selected Requirement: 97

Public Health Reports



- To facilitate coordination with schools and PCP during a disease outbreak
- ## #,% and list of children by district, school and grade:
 - ***past due
 - **eligible but not past due
 - ***series complete
 - no information in IIS
 - ***PCP name and phone # are included



Other Uses of Roster Data



- ***Ad Hoc Reports
 - **Example: HPV rates by district, by school
- ***Share immunization data with school information systems
- Medical examiner access to roster data for coordination with schools during child death investigations
- ***School lead screening requirements
- ***Oral Health Dental Sealant Program

Limitations



- ***Public schools only
- ***Data are updated monthly
 - Roster data less stable in fall
- Not used for school assessment
 - **IIS may not have all vaccination records
 - ***Signed consent is needed for schools to send records to IIS
