

IIS Measurement and Improvement


An effort engaging the entire IIS community to:

Core Functional Standards Measures and tests are focused on the IIS Functional Standards, and improvement will help IIS meet core functions




Long-Term Time and Cost Savings We believe there will be an offset – time spend standardizing will be time saved in onboarding for non-standard interfaces

- Focus should stay on HL7 2.5.1 Release 1.5




