

Repurpose "Offering Benefits" to "Promoting Value"


 Definition of value. 1: a fair return or equivalent in goods, services, or money for something exchanged.







Prioritize & Engage Stakeholders

- Identify stakeholders are most critical for the success of the IIS
- Determine what about the IIS provides the greatest value to those stakeholders
- Measure to demonstrate value for their investment

 - 27 Functional Standards

Capability Prioritization: CDC Example

- IIS Business Plan Guidance
 - 4 foundational areas 22 OGS
 - Childhood data completeness (i.e., 0 to 6 years of age)
 - Pediatric Clinical Decision Support (CDS) for immunizations
 - Coverage estimates for childhood vaccinations (i.e., jurisdictional and provider-based)
 - Bidirectional exchange with EHRs within the awardee's jurisdiction using published CDC standards

Align Resources


- Human and financial resources

 - Realign IISSB staff roles/responsibilities






Measure Progress & Success: CDC & AIRA Examples
