# ECDC role in strengthening efforts on IIS in the EU

- In response to EU council request and suggestions from EU Member States
  - Nov. 2015: Established a Technical Expert Group on IIS

#### - Objectives:

- To discuss the benefits of designing, developing and implementing electronic immunisation information systems
- To review the benefits of IIS towards vaccination programme management and monitoring
- To review the steps needed towards the development of a technical guideline
- To set-up a technical expert group that could allow for continuation of mutual support across countries within and beyond the EU



## Some of the challenges in the EU

- Complexity of the vaccination programme delivery in some countries: Numerous stakeholders involved in offering the vaccines. Who should be reporting to the IIS?
- Need for supporting legislation and recommendation by national authorities: Data protection, data security are bottle necks
  - Supportive pieces: EU council conclusions on vaccination, WHO EURO Vaccine Action Plan are essential
- Need for a clear understanding of the benefits of IIS by all stakeholders [from the public to political level] the selling point what's in it for me you us?
- Need to offer technical solutions and standards

- To collaborate across countries and institutions




### **EU-wide survey**

#### **ECDC Technical Guidance document**

#### Scope:

- Harmonise and clarify terminology
- Advocacy material for introduction of IIS;
   benefits for stakeholders
- Guidance on functional standards
- Minimal data standards to fulfil functionalities
- General framework for system implementation
- Audience: countries establishing an IIS, as well as countries strengthening their IIS



#### Value outside of Europe

- The survey offers insight into what's in place in Europe
- The technical guide will provide use case studies throughout the guide
- Both documents can help find relevant collaboration partners
  - Common issues to discuss
  - Sharing lessons learned




## Value outside of Europe II
