## JANUARY RECAP

#### **Assessment Steering Committee**

- The Education Steering Committee hosted a webinar on January 17<sup>th</sup> to introduce ASC's most recent guide: <u>Comparing and Communicating Vaccination Coverage</u> <u>Estimates from IIS, the National Immunization Survey, and Related Assessments</u>. The webinar featured speakers from AIRA, Minnesota, and New York City.
- The ASC meets on quarterly basis and the next meeting will be held on March 6<sup>th</sup> at 2pm ET.

#### Standards and Interoperability Steering Committee

- The Standards and Interoperability Steering Committee (SISC) met on January 10<sup>th</sup> and discussed the recent release of the draft Trusted Exchange Framework. Deloitte also provided an overview of the Vaccine Code Sets Management Service release. The committee also continued discussing revisions to the SISC charter and workplan.
- The SISC Technical Workgroup met on January 24<sup>th</sup> and further reviewed the draft Trusted Exchange Framework. The workgroup also discussed the comments AIRA has received to date.

#### **Education Steering Committee**

- The Education Steering Committee (ESC) met on January 17<sup>th</sup> and received an update on Public Health Informatics Institute's online learning modules and IIS New Managers Workshop.
- The next edition of SnapShots will be published in the spring. All articles must be submitted to <u>Katie Reed</u> by February 14<sup>th</sup>.
- The steering committee brainstormed about focus topics for the 2018 Education Plan, which is being used to drive education efforts for AIRA members and stakeholders throughout the year. The ESC also reviewed an updated version of their charter.

#### **MIROW Steering Committee**

- The MIROW Steering Committee (SC) met on January 25th to discuss the next steps in the MIROW strategic planning efforts.
- The SC has three subgroups tasked with the following items:

- Repackaging Workgroup: This workgroup will identify a new outline for MIROW guides to make them more user friendly. The PAIS guide was selected as the first pilot project. The group has begun working on drafts of the new repackaged guide and a timeline for release.
- Common Vocabulary/Domain Workgroup: The domain model is a common section in every MIROW guide which defines the terminology in a guide. This workgroup is in the process of reviewing previous MIROW guides and developing a consolidated domain model for all MIROW work. This document will be updated annually moving forward (or as new topics are developed).
- Promotional Workgroup: This workgroup will identify new ways to promote MIROW guides and improve implementation of guides. Abstracts were submitted for NIC and the AIRA National Meeting to promote MIROW materials/concepts. The workgroup is also working on revising AIRA's MIROW website and abstracts for additional conferences.
