Information Requested: We are interested to know from other IIS:

- How does your IIS handle consumer access to your IIS?
- Do you allow direct access or not and what information is the consumer required to provide?

Results:

WA: The Office of Immunization and Child Profile in Washington State has been part of the MyIR pilot for the last four years. MyIR is a consumer access portal that allows people to sign up to get their and their family's immunization information online. Once someone is signed up, they'll see their official immunization record and forecast and can print the Certificate of Immunization Status pre-populated right from the portal.

We only allow access through MyIR. When people with accounts look at their records, it queries the Washington State Immunization Information System, which sends the consumer's data to his or her MyIR account. This means accounts are updated in real time—once an immunization is entered in the IIS, it will show up the next time the person logs in to their account. There are several ways someone can sign up and they have to provide information that matches their record in the IIS. If they don't have an IIS record, they aren't able to create an account.
