



Topic: Official Immunization Forms

Information Requested:

We are in the process of updating our official immunization record. Without looking at the immunization details page, you would not be able to ascertain what vaccines were given and whether the vaccine was part of a two or three-dose regimen (for example, Bexero- 2 doses vs. Trumenba 2 or 3 doses). This may be an issue for those providers who may not be a part of the registry or are an out-of-state provider only receiving the official immunization record.

2. Does anyone include vaccine type as a field on the official immunization record? If so, would you be able to provide a copy?

 - o Minnesota has two reports available in MIIC that users can print out to provide individuals who may not participate in the IIS or are an out-of-state-provider.
 - Complete Immunization Report (attached: MIIC_CompleteImmReport)
 - MIIC Immunization Report (attached: MIIC_ImmReport)
 - o Both reports include information regarding what vaccines were given and what dose they are in a series.
 - Complete Immunization Report- fields are Immunization and Series
 - MIIC Immunization Report – fields are Vaccine Type and Dose Number
2. Does anyone include vaccine type as a field on the official immunization record? If so, would you be able to provide a copy?
 - o Minnesota include vaccine group on both reports
 - Complete Immunization Report- field is Immunization

- MIIC Immunization Report – field is Vaccine Type
- MN includes only trade name on the Complete Immunization Report – field is Trade Name
- MN includes both vaccine and trade name on the MIIC Immunization Report- Field is Vaccine (Trade Name)

ND:

North Dakota prints vaccine type but not brand name on our official certificate of immunization. We also include dose validity on the certificate.

PR:

Puerto Rico does not include it and I agree with you that this is an issue. And this is the same problem for Hib and rotavirus.
