Address Cleansing




- No cost service with SmartyStreets







- AFIX → IQIP (Immunization Quality Improvement for Providers)

AFIX Pre-Visit Readiness Checklist

BEFORE GETTING STARTED

- Request or calculate the appropriate birthdate range(s) based on the date of assessment (typically 1- 5 business days before the visit date)
- ☐ Optional: Run an initial coverage assessment using the IIS

CONFIRM ACTIVE PATIENTS

- ☐ Use the IIS to generate a list of active patients associated with your facility for the specified birthdate range
- $\hfill \square$ Compare the IIS list to patients in your EHR and make note of patients that are no


Results: Transport




Results: Submission and Acknowledgement

The Aggregate Analysis Reporting Tool (AART)








