








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AIRA Update

AIRA Members & Partners Meeting 3-18-19

Provider Participation Community of Practice

Kicked off late February, 2019, with 7 participating states

 Goals: Improve provider participation in participating states and develop best practices that can apply nationally

Participants:

- IIS and Immunization Programs (AL, CA, CO, IL, MD, NM, TN)
- Health care providers from the states' local AAP Chapters
- National partners (AIRA, AIM, AAP, AAP, and CDC)

Methods:

- Individual assessment of barriers and plans to address them
- One-on-one sessions with technical assistance from CDC and CDC contractor
- Mentoring by other state IIS programs

Coverage Assessment Highlights

- NIS-IIS Match Project (aligns with IPOM Strategy D1)
 - Evaluation of data completeness
 - Option to match to 2018 NIS-Child, NIS-Teen, or both
 - Requires a data use agreement with CDC contractor
 - Estimated cost per match is NIS-Child: \$58,128 and NIS-Teen: \$58,971
- If interested, contact your project officer and designate this as a Direct Assistance funding request in the 2019 application cycle

CDSi Update

Recent Developments

- Version 4.0 of the Logic Specification, Supporting Data, and Routinely Recommended Age-Based Test Cases have been published.
 - https://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/programs/iis/cdsi.html
 - Most changes were around better support of historical recommendations and skip logic for certain vaccines. The full list of changes and additions are included in the appendices and release notes for the resources.
 - Risk-Based Test cases will be published in the coming weeks.
- At the February ACIP meeting, voted on updates to the Japanese Encephalitis and Anthrax recommendations.
 - CDSi will update its resources accordingly once the MMWRs are drafted and published.

CDSi Informational Workgroup

- The next Workgroup meeting is scheduled for April 15th from 12-1pm EST.
- We will discuss:
 - The ACIP February votes and product updates.
 - The prospect of CDSi issuing draft (or pre-release) material to help speed up implementation following ACIP votes for the yearly flu recommendation.
 - The 4.0 CDSi publication and next steps.




