TennIIS

TN's first IIS was established 1995

Migration to TennIIS in 2014


- Reporting to TennIIS is voluntary for most providers in TN
 - Reporting is mandatory for:
 - Public Health Departments
 - Vaccines for Children (VFC) participants (effective January 1, 2017)



TN School Immunization Requirements

 Official TN Certificate of Immunization is required for school admission

 Certificates are available from medical offices, health departments, or the state Immunization Registry





TennIIS and School Users

School outreach to add users in 2015-2016

 Goal: At least 1 TennIIS user in all 144 school districts by 2017

- School users were given "view-only" access
- Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA)



Developing the Pilot Project


 TN Department of Health (TDH) and TN Department of Education (TDOE) collaboration

Email invitations sent to 30 school nurses

- Live training webinars conducted April 2017
 - 15 initial participants trained




Expanding "Expanded Access"

- Additional trainings conducted throughout 2017
 - 2 live trainings at TN Association of School Nurses in October
- 173 expanded access users in 41 school districts by end of 2017.
- Goal: At least one expanded access user in half of all school districts by the end of 2018.
- As of June 2019: 570 expanded access users trained across 95 public school districts and 9 private schools




Number of Expanded Access Users Added






Number of New Patient Records Added

 Tennessee's annual Kindergarten Immunization Compliance Assessment is done by a census survey of over 74,000 kindergarten students.


TennIIS data is used in the initial review

Kindergarten Immunization Compliance Assessment


Kindergarten Records Complete in TennIIS 2015-2018
