Chicago:

No, we do not receive any other funding.

ME:

No, we do not receive any other funding for IIS operations.

MN:

Yes, we do receive some non-CDC funding. We get some 90/10 funding, though we've only had that available to us for the past 2 years or so. We do not receive any state or other funding for IIS Ops.

RI:

Rhode Island law requires insurers to provide vaccine funding for insured children and adults and sets aside up to 15% of the funding for administrative costs, including the registry. Annual assessments are based on direct premiums written in the year prior to the assessment.
