





All Awardee Meeting

- Training and discussion on a variety of program areas with a <u>special</u> <u>emphasis on the IIS</u>
- Topics: data quality, IIS platform consortia, IIS cost tracking, future technology considerations, and procuring IIS goods and services
- Audience: Immunization Program Managers, IIS managers, and other key staff
- January 28-30



Technical Assistance Collaborative

- CDC, AIRA, and PHII working together to:
 - Exchange existing information and develop a shared understanding of each awardee's progress
 - Identify a set of activities for each awardee that can help them improve in identified challenge areas and to incorporate into their 2020 applications
 - Identify TA opportunities
- Results will help shape CDC guidance for awardees
- Ongoing effort to ensure coordination

Procurement Workshop

- CDC and PHII had a 2 day procurement workshop for awardees who are preparing for or in the early stages of a new IIS-related procurement. Topics included:
 - Governance
 - Developing requirements
 - Developing a solicitation
 - Post-award activities
- 7 jurisdictions, 14 people

Reminder: SMaRT AFIX

CDC-funded implementation and maintenance support end in FY 20. Awardees need to plan accordingly.

- Any awardee that has implemented and is currently using SMaRT AFIX to generate provider-level coverage reports should incorporate maintenance costs into their IIS budget beginning October 1, 2020
- Any awardee implementing SMaRT AFIX with help from J Michael Consulting must complete activities to implement in their production environment prior to September 4, 2020, and incorporate maintenance costs into the IIS budget beginning October 1, 2020

SMaRT AFIX (continued)

- Awardees with NO ability to generate provider-level coverage reports
 - iWeb--should consider implementing SmaRT AFIX
 - Non-iWeb—next steps vary based on implementation timeline.
 However, it is unlikely that new implementations would benefit from cost savings prior to the end of the maintenance contract.
- Awardees with ability to generate provider-level coverage reports
 - No action needed



Patient Status

- Document is now available in the AIRA repository
- Purpose: bridge the gap between currently published guidance and actual implementation by IIS
- The primary audiences
 - IIS managers
 - IIS staff with responsibility for data quality
 - Immunization program staff that work with providers



IIS Capabilities/Limitations in Outbreak Response and Identifying Pockets of Need

- Responses from 59 programs
- Learn about IIS successes/challenges in responding to outbreaks so that these lessons can be shared widely
- Information will be used to help determine which jurisdictions could use technical assistance in using the IIS to identify pockets of need




AIRA 2020 National Meeting

 Meeting this week to discuss the measures and tests for ingoing/oncoming data, as well as the timeline and thresholds for moving CDS testing to Validation




Updates
