

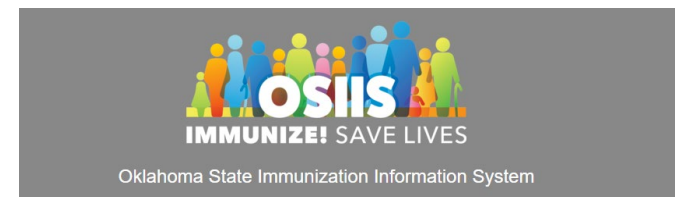

# OSIIS HISTORY

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- Established in 1994
- Homegrown system
- Designed to collect and maintain accurate, complete, and current immunization records for Oklahomans of all ages
- Use of OSIIS is encouraged though not mandated
- Latest version – Enhanced OSIIS (OTS)
  - Launched November 2, 2020



# REASONS FOR TRANSITION

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- Did not meet national IIS functional requirements
- Not able to fully integrate with providers Electronic Health Records (EHR)
- No inventory reconciliation process
- Upgrades were cost prohibitive
- Difficulty with updating vaccine schedules



# OSIIS TRANSITION

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- June 28, 2019
- Original go-live October 26, 2020
- Actual go-live November 2, 2020
