Background

The Aggregate Analysis Reporting Tool ([AART](#)) is an application specifically developed to support the [Measurement and Improvement \(M&I\) initiative](#) to visualize and compile results and information on community-driven measures and tests related to the [immunization information system \(IIS\) Functional Standards](#). AART accomplishes this task by displaying test results for an IIS along with information and suggestions for improvements.

The tool is developed and supported by AIRA and is hosted on secure servers maintained by AIRA. AIRA technical staff routinely update AART, which impacts various IIS-specific reports, system features, and user navigation.

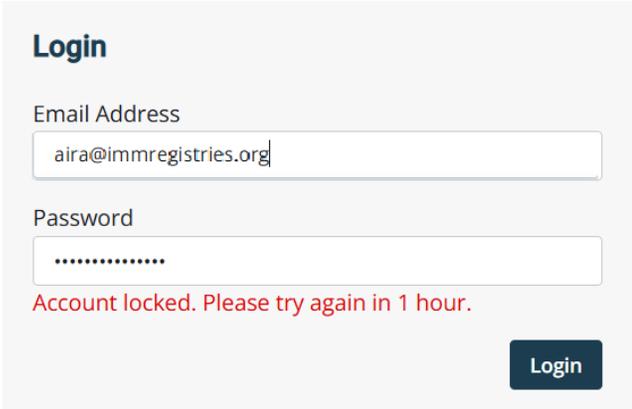
Subject: Automatic Session Timeouts

AART user account will be locked for 1 hour after 10 failed login attempts. See [AIRA Security Guidance](#) for more information.

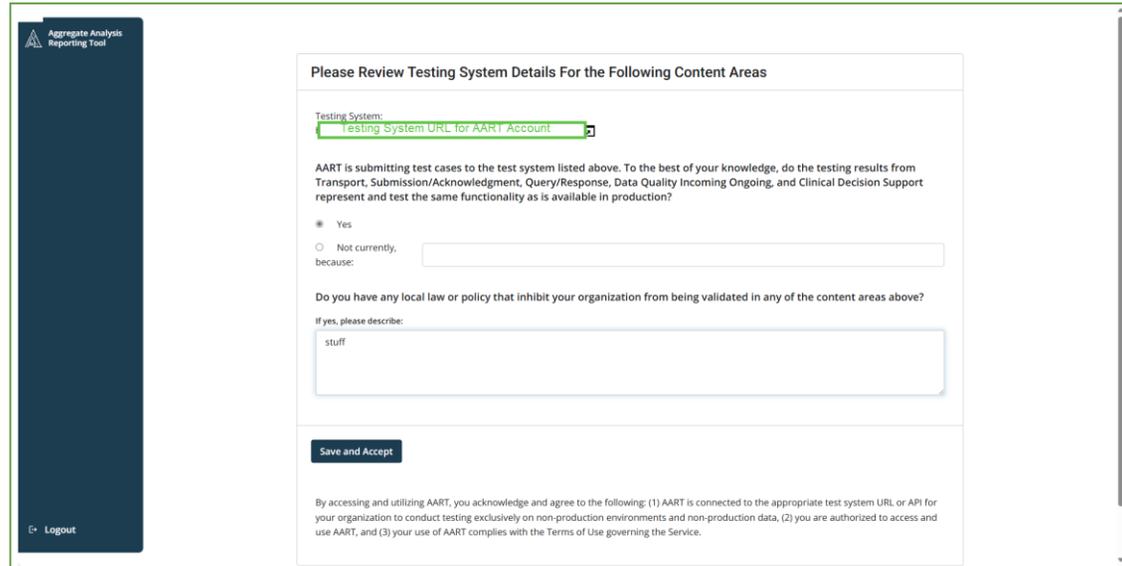

Subject: Yearly Testing System Verification

Every year in January, AART admins will see the Verification of Testing System Details screen immediately upon logging in to AART. AART will not allow the AART admins to bypass the screen until responses to the questions are provided. This verification coincides with the annual validation of content areas tested for M&I. If a jurisdiction has more than one AART admin, only one administrator needs to respond to the questions. AART admins are also able to view historical responses within AART interface.
