


Project Objective

- Determine competencies that are:
 - Addressed in existing PHII LMS courses or existing external content.
 - Not addressed by internal or external LMS courses.
- Develop summary and recommendations report.

Quality Rubric for eLearning Courses

Required

Learning objectives must map to one or more <u>IIS Competency Model statements</u>. This
will ensure a direct one-to-one link between IIS workforce training and the required
knowledge, skills and abilities for performance success.

Required

- Course content must be relevant and up-to-date. The course content must not contain inaccurate information.
- A post-course evaluation allows learners to provide feedback on the perceived learning effectiveness. An evaluation allows PHII to obtain learner insights for use in the continuous improvement of courses.
- A knowledge assessment validates the learner's understanding. An assessment allows
 the learner to verify comprehension or (preferably) applied knowledge.
- A certificate evidences successful course completion. Learners may desire a certificate for professional development Continuing Education Units (CEUs) or as evidence for performance appraisal purposes.
- Resources and reference information are provided. Downloadable job aids, checklists, and/or quick reference guides and links to documentation or standards are provided to support job performance.
- Course content is free. Courses must be available at no cost for inclusion in PHII learning paths to promote accessibility to all jurisdictions regardless of funding status.
