Develop strategies to assist IIS and multi-jurisdictional vaccine providers with connecting and exchanging data through IZ Gateway



Track and monitor completion of interjurisdictional MOUs



IIP Key Updates

- Modular test plan was reviewed and approved by CDC, 3 EHR vendors interested in testing & 2 in retesting to extend recognition
- IIP Collaborative:
 - **Vaccine-related code sets** article being finalized and will be published soon
 - **Immunization data exchange with pharmacies** landscape analysis: planning for SME interviews





Our cooperative agreement with CDC supports Immunize.org to make available Vaccine Information Statement (VIS) translations. Providing a translation along with the current English VIS reduces barriers to important vaccination information for people whose preferred language is not English.

We add new VIS translations as they become available to us. We produce translations of all VISs in many common languages and rely on generous partner organizations for translations in additional languages. However, because we rely on donated translations for some languages, all VISs are not available in all represented languages.





Functional Standards (FS) update project




- PHII has convened a workgroup of IIS community members to develop recommendations for updating the FS
