PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Dear IIS partners,

Happy spring! Hopefully, this finds most of you enjoying slightly warmer weather and longer days of light than during the winter months. We are excited to share the first *Snapshots* edition of the year with you. This edition highlights the usefulness of Aggregate Analysis Reporting Tool (AART) Clinics. For those of you who have ever read an AART report and thought, "What does this mean?" or "What do I do now?"—the AART Clinics are what you've been missing. These in-person clinics are offered yearly at the AIRA National Meeting and provide an opportunity to dive deep into your AART results with technical and subject matter experts, ideally equipping you with actionable next steps as follow-up. AART Clinics have quickly become a favorite attraction of the AIRA National Meeting, and this year's national gathering will be no exception.

This edition also includes an incredibly useful resource from the Public Health Informatics Institute (PHII)—the Immunization information system (IIS) Procurement Toolkit—and some thoughts on rightsizing security in public health information systems. Solicitation and procurement of any IT system can be painful, overly complex, and burdensome. PHII's toolkit provides 23 different templates to help jurisdictions better navigate the challenges of IIS procurement. Having gone through a massive IIS solicitation and migration more than 13 years ago, I wish this resource had existed then! It's far better to learn from others than reinvent the wheel.

Finally, we are quickly approaching the AIRA 2024 National Meeting scheduled for May 7-9 in Orlando, Florida! AIRA received an incredible amount of interest from potential presenters through the abstract submission process. Thanks to AIRA staff, a thoughtfully crafted agenda has been drafted delivering high-quality programming to all attendees.





Incredible Growth!

From 2012 to 2023, AIRA's National Meeting has experienced a 114% growth rate.










