2. Share and engage the IIS community on important issues and emerging trends from within the health information and technology landscape.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◆ Develop and disseminate key messages that address issues and trends impacting IIS.◆ Provide educational offerings to the IIS community about new and emerging issues and technologies.◆ Engage the community to respond to key issues that may impact IIS.◆ Identify and cultivate IIS influencers to enhance their understanding of core health IT issues impacting the IIS community.
3. Share and engage the broader health IT community on important issues impacting IIS.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◆ Develop and disseminate key messages highlighting the value, challenges, and issues impacting IIS.◆ Provide targeted education about IIS and the IIS community to key partners.◆ Identify key data exchange partners to encourage more widespread and impactful use of IIS data.◆ Participate with the broader health IT and public health community to inform and respond to key issues that impact IIS.◆ Engage external stakeholders in creating collaborative solutions.

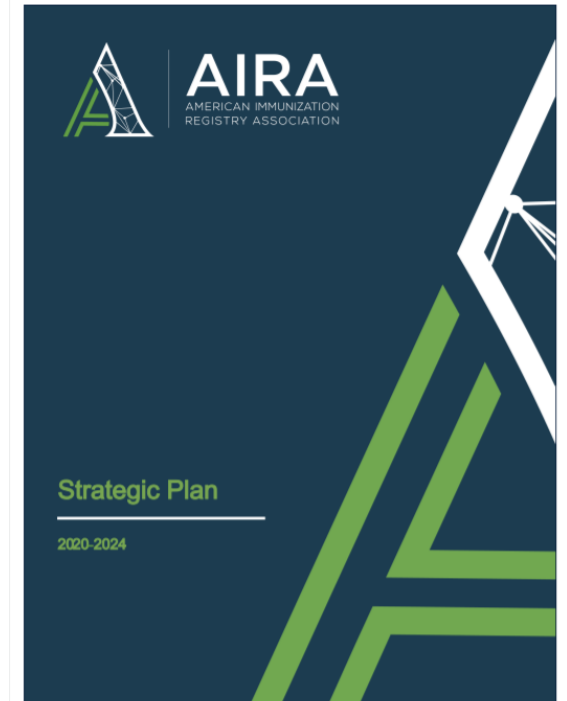
