ISSAR Overview and Purpose



What is the ISSAR?

- Semi-annual performance assessment of Immunization Information Systems (IIS)
- Required for programs funded under Section 317b of the Public Health Service Act
- Evaluates development, maintenance, and enhancement of IIS
- Covers a 1.5 year reporting period



Purpose of the ISSAR

- **Monitor** IIS performance and progress
- **Support** data-driven immunization programs
- **Ensure alignment** with national standards
- **Strengthen** public health infrastructure

IISSAR Methodology and 2026 Changes



IISSAR Methodology

- Self-reported, self-validated survey
- Completed by immunization program recipients
- Administered by Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
- Data may be reviewed and validated post-submission



2026 IISSAR Changes

- Redesigned to align with [IIS Functional Standards](#)
- Reorganized around **four program goals**:
 - Data quality
 - Interoperability
 - Emergency response
 - Modernization
- The IISSAR does **not** measure all functional standards or operational guidance statements

ISSAR Submission Requirements and Reporting Period



- One report per IIS
- Reporting period is July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026
- Awardees must **complete** the questionnaire by **July 31, 2026**
- Submitted by Program Manager or designee

IISSAR Question Cadence and Time Periods

The table below indicates the reporting cadence and time periods for questions on the [IISSAR questionnaire](#). It is intended to help respondents plan the time needed to complete the questionnaire.

Note: jurisdictions not submitting line-level data must answer 18 questions every 6 months that line-level data reporters are not required to answer.
