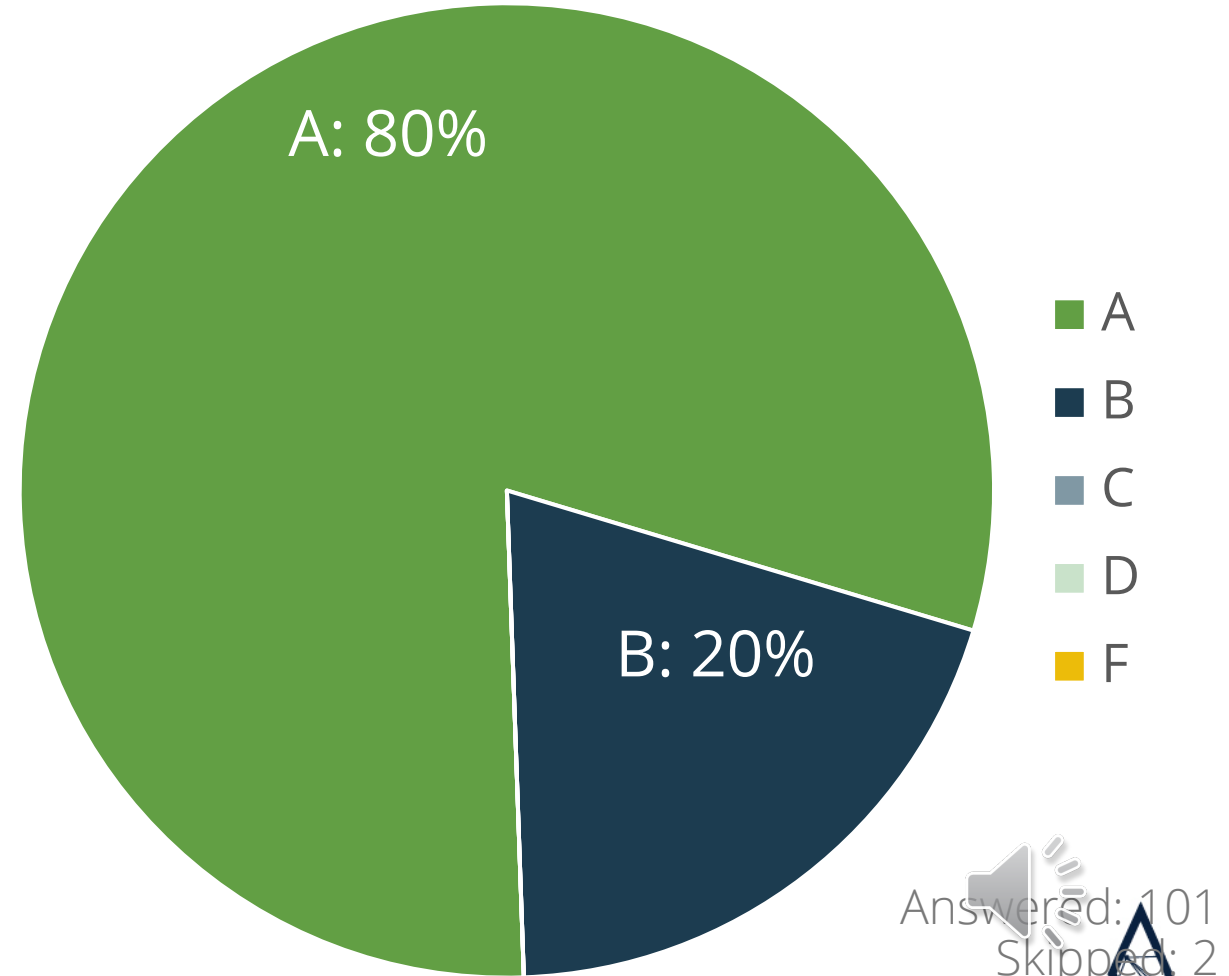


Meeting Registrants by Role

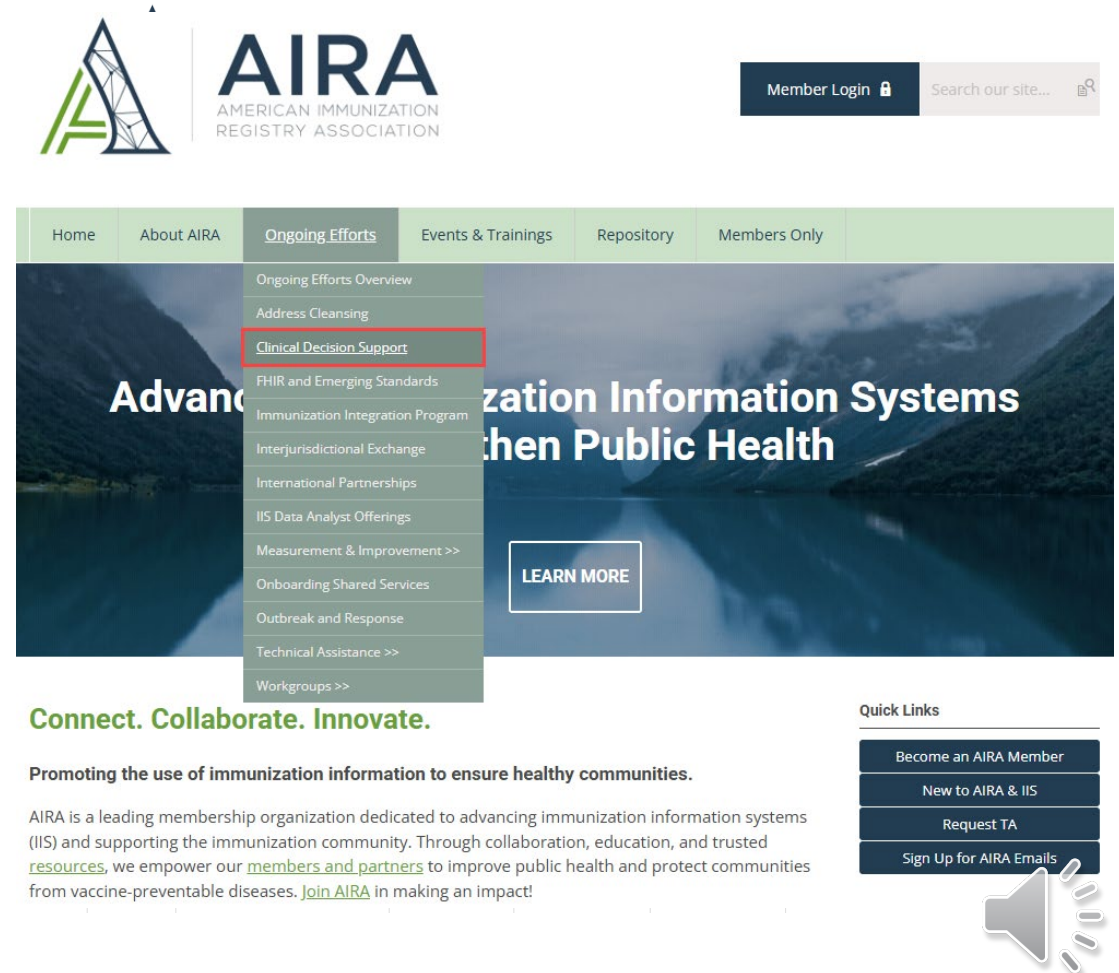

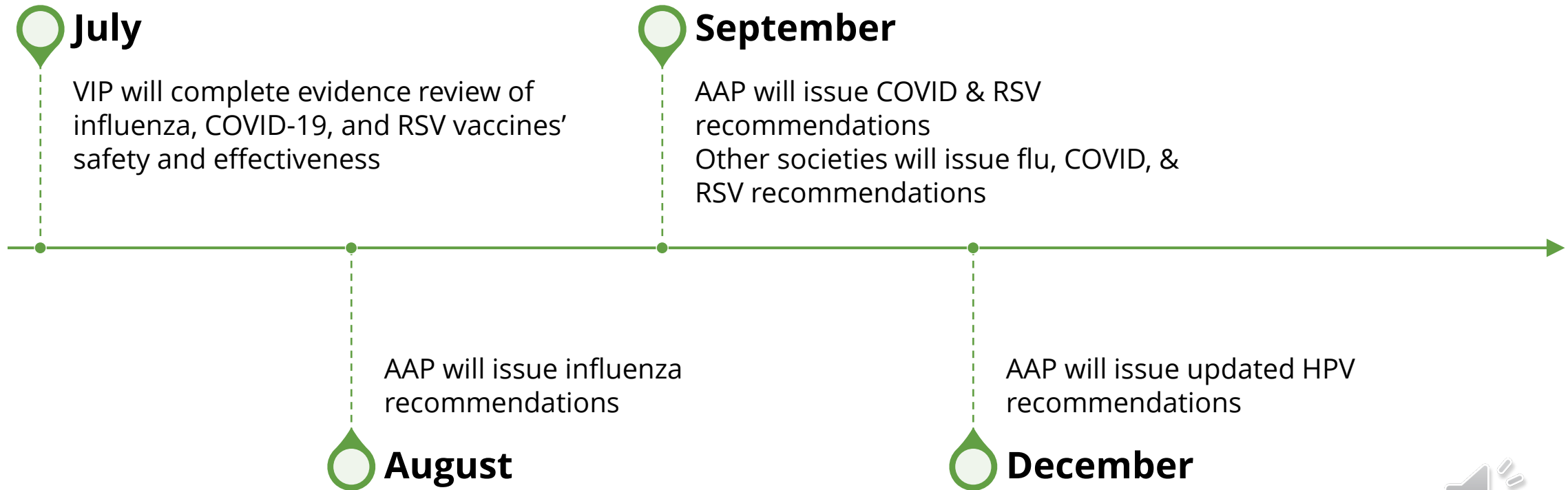

Upcoming Data Submission Deadlines



Quarterly Routine Vaccination Data Submission

Include all vaccinations reported to the IIS through June 30, 2026.

- Data Specifications: Use Appendices E and F, version 35, and Appendix G, version 1.
- Privacy Preserving Record Linkage (PPRL) Specifications: Use Appendix H, version 6.

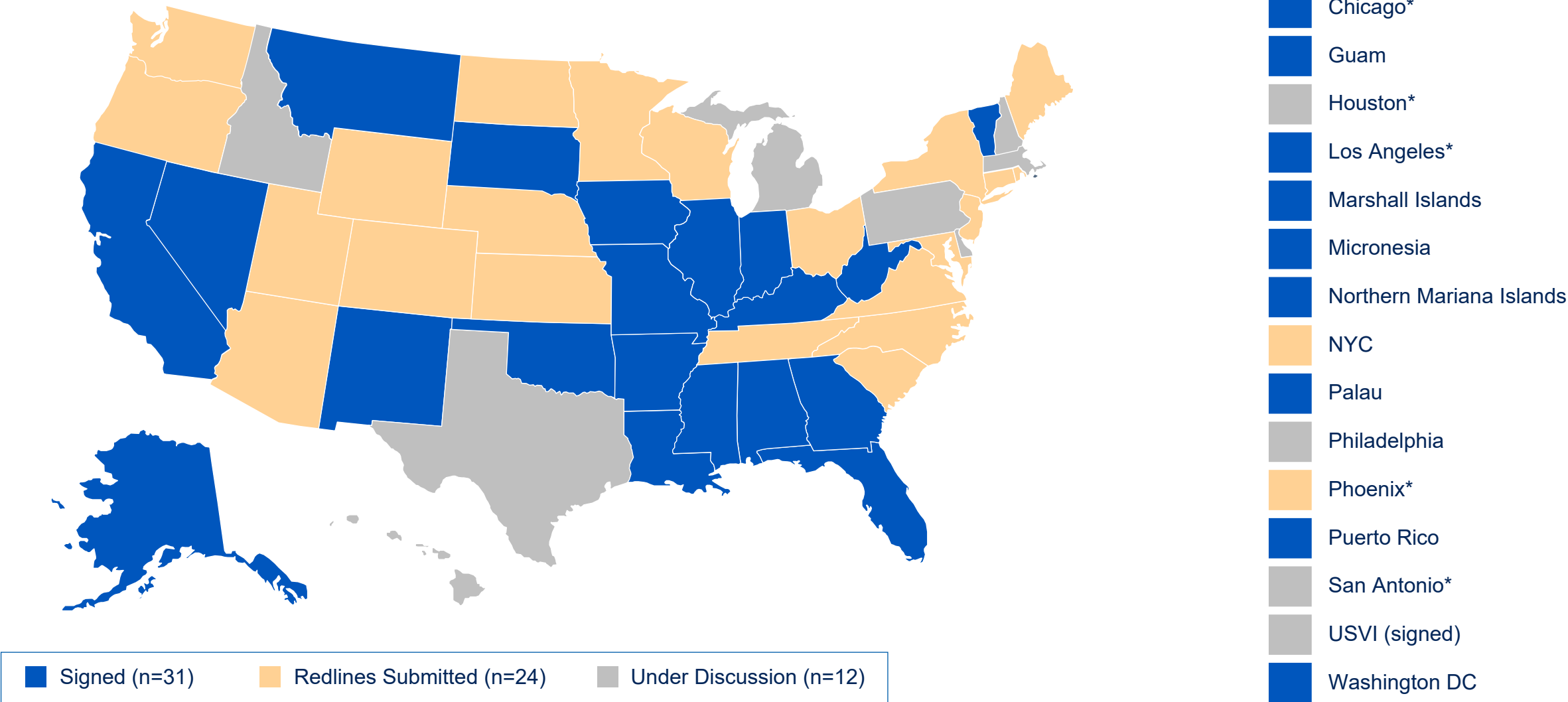


Monthly Aggregate Flu Vaccination Data Submission Paused

The submission of monthly aggregate flu vaccination data due August 9 has been paused.

- IDAB is awaiting the release of 2026-2027 respiratory virus code sets and will share updated templates and reporting instructions for flu, RSV, and COVID-19 for the new season soon.
- Flu, RSV, and COVID-19 submissions are expected to resume in fall 2026.

CDC Approves Routine and Seasonal Immunization DUA Version 4



Data Use Agreement (DUA) Version 4

CDC approved [Routine and Seasonal Immunization DUA Version 4](#), which incorporates key language from prior versions for continuity and consistency

It is now a **standalone agreement**



Jurisdictions with Signed DUAs

CDC will apply the approved changes and updates automatically



All Other Jurisdictions

Review and **execute DUA Version 4**



Requests for Additional Edits

Must include citable state law/statute showing legal limits on data sharing/use

Edits not related to a jurisdictional law or statute are not allowed

Corrective Action Plan Update



ISD is not moving forward with a Corrective Action Plan for jurisdictions that have not yet signed an agreement.

- IDAB has worked with immunization funding recipients for over a year to secure current signed agreements to submit data to CDC, as required under NOFO 25-0007.
- Feedback from jurisdictions and legal teams helped inform **revisions to the DUA**, in coordination with the CDC Office of General Counsel.
- **DUA Version 4** addresses jurisdictions that could not sign an addendum to an expired DUA.
- IDAB will continue working with any recipients that still need to sign a DUA and submit data to meet the requirement within the 5 -year cooperative agreement period.

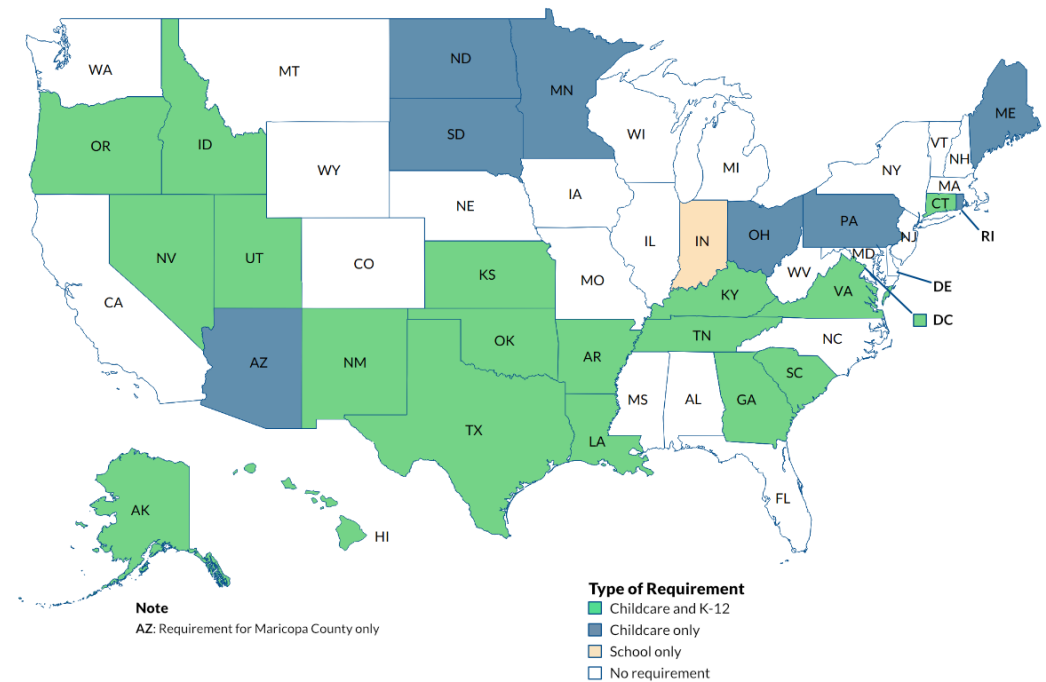

State Hepatitis A Vaccine Requirements for Childcare and School (K-12)

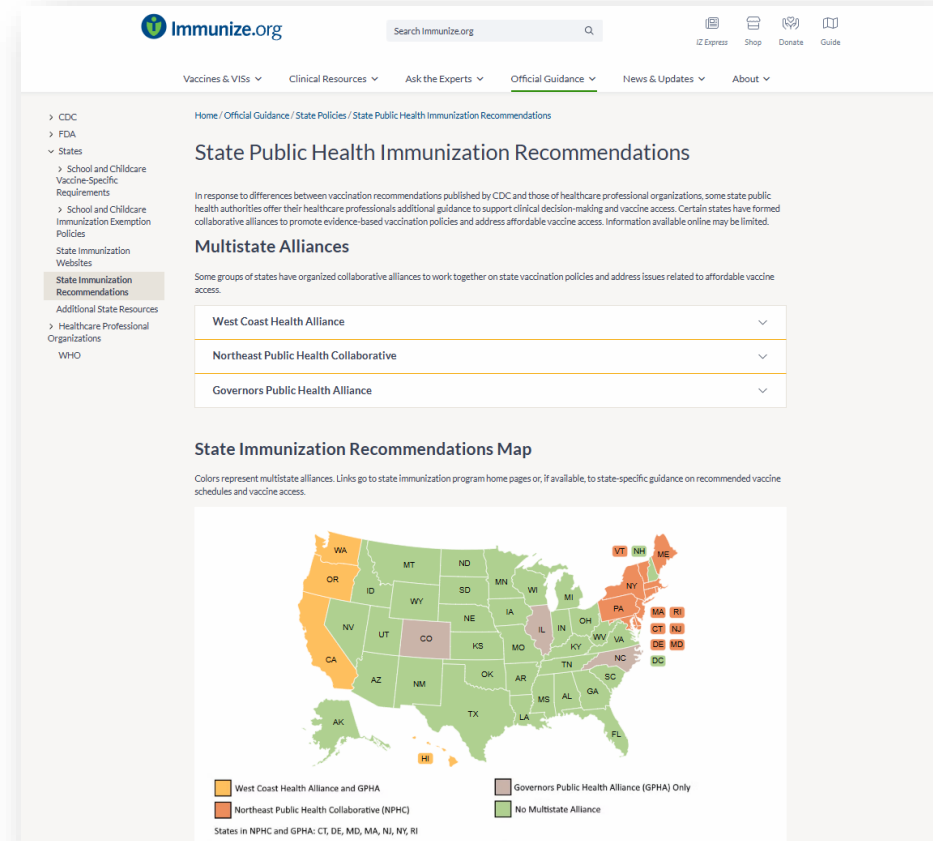

Upcoming Immunization Recommendations Guidance and Promotions

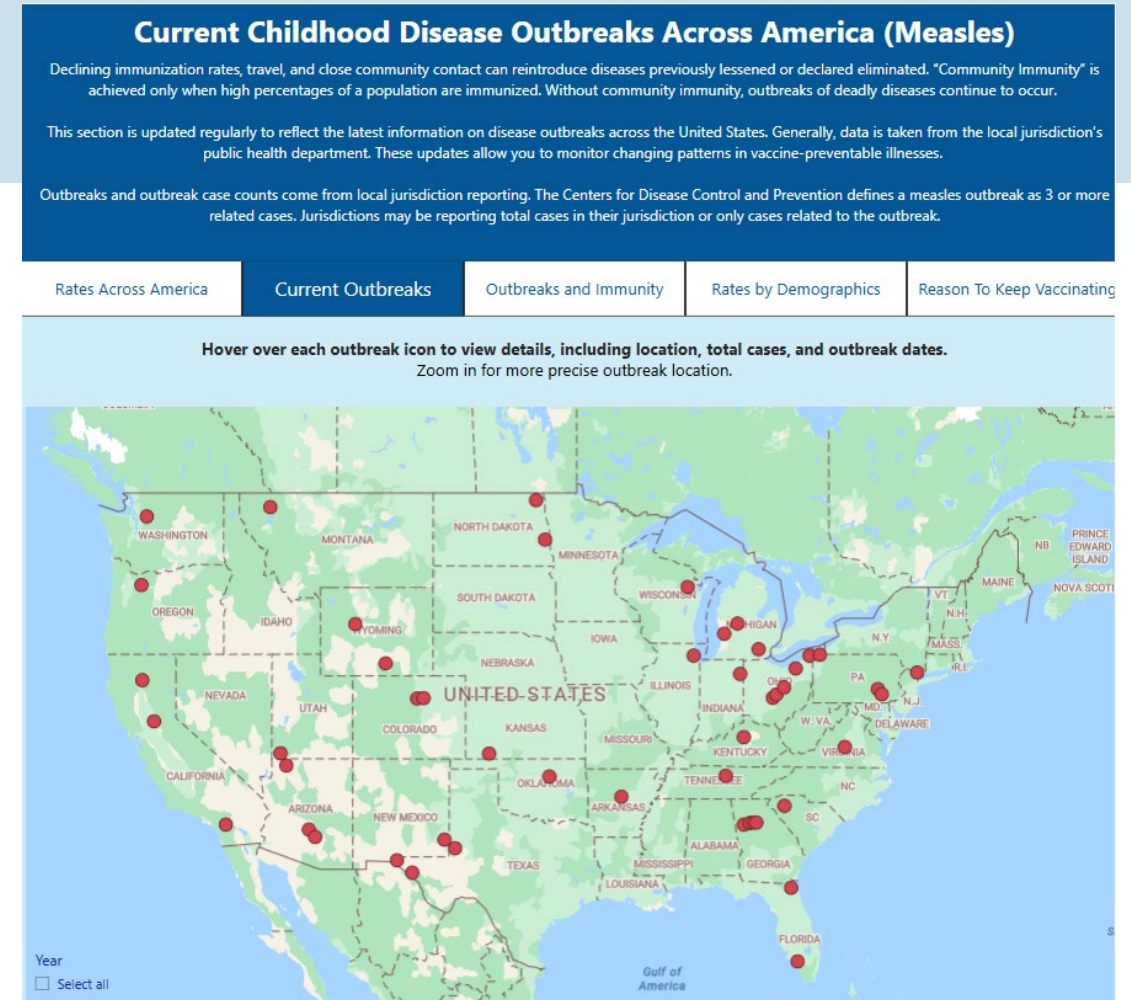
- Flu guidance will be released in mid-August

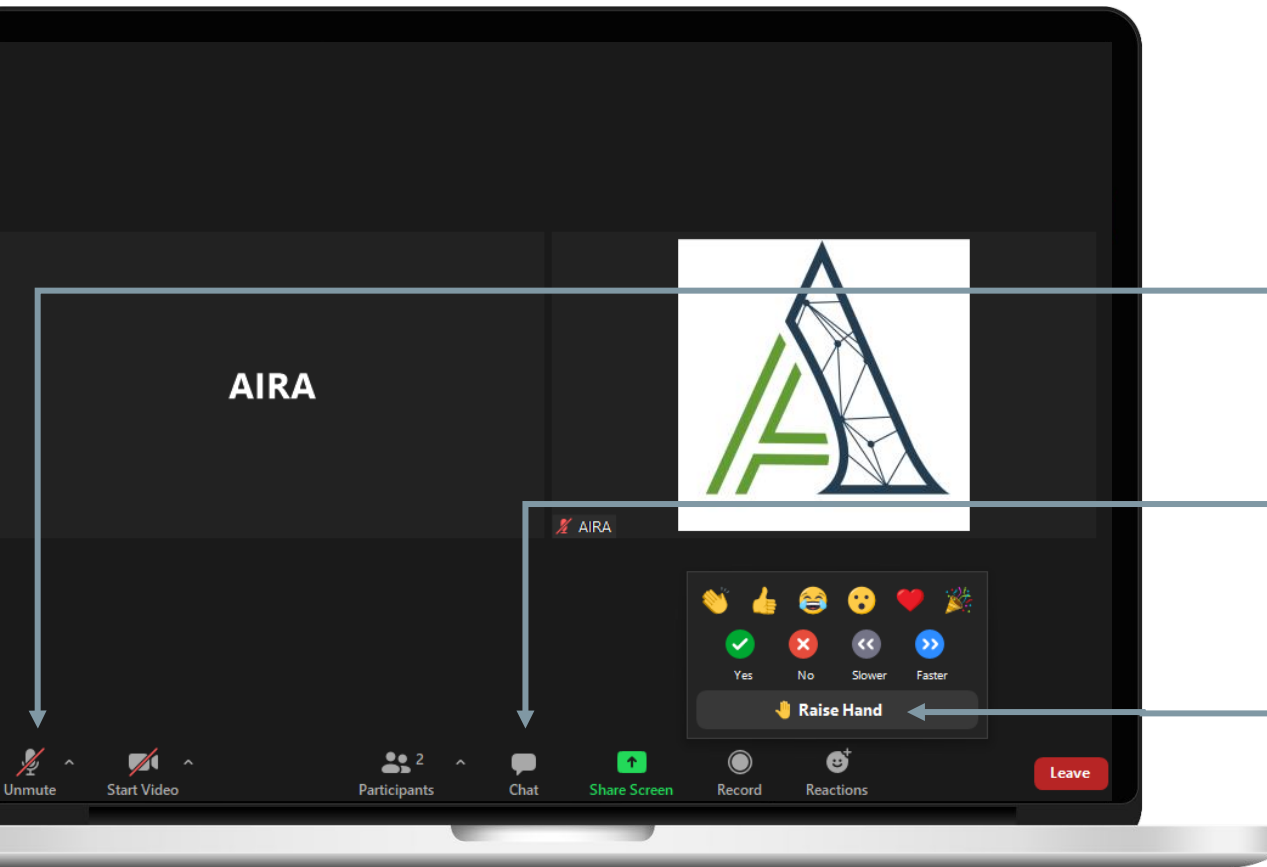

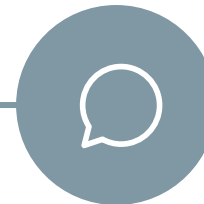

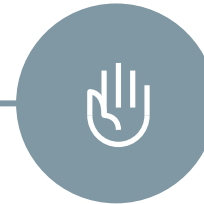
